INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Section 1. Intellectual property created, made, or originated by a Graduate Student Worker (GSW) shall be the sole and exclusive property of the GSW except as the GSW may voluntarily choose to transfer such property, in full or in part.

Section 2. The University shall not engage in any form of retaliation against a GSW who engages in any effort to enforce their ownership rights in Section 1. The University shall also not retaliate against any GSW who participates in any other investigation or forum regarding intellectual property rights and or academic integrity, including but not limited to, patent or copyright disputes and investigations of scholarly misconduct, such as but not limited to plagiarism of their published or unpublished work.
